

PESTICIDES (PACKAGING AND LABELLING) REGULATIONS 1978

Pesticides Control Act - Section 33 – 18 August 1978

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pesticides (Packaging and Labelling) Regulations 1978.
2. No specified substance in liquid form shall be sold except in a package which-
 - (a) is of such a size as to accommodate a label of twelve by twelve centimeters;
 - (b) bears the word "POISON" embossed or hardbaked painted in red on the package;
 - (c) is sealed to make it safe to handle.
3. (1) No specified substance in solid form shall be sold except in-
 - (a) a sealed outer polyethelene bag which-
 - (i) is of such a size as to accommodate a label of twelve by twelve centimeters;
 - (ii) is transparent; and
 - (b) a sealed inner polyethelene bag of a thickness which is not less than-
 - (i) 0.07 millimeter when the contents weigh less than one pound;
 - (ii) 0.1 millimeter when the contents weigh more than one pound.
4. These regulations shall not apply to a specified substance sold to the public in the package in which it is imported.
