## Pharmacy and Poisons (Prohibition of Harmful Drugs) Regulations 1982

## GN 120/1982

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 57 of the Pharmacy Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Prohibition of Harmful Drugs) Regulations 1982.
- 2. In these regulations-
  - "harmful drug" means a substance mentioned in the Schedule.
- 3. No person shall import, manufacture, keep, store, distribute, sell, export, use, possess or otherwise deal with any harmful drug.
- 4. Any person who contravenes these regulations shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding 1,000 rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months.

- 14. Any preparation containing any substance specified in paragraphs 2 to 13.
