(a) Inspecting and checking the Licensee's water and wastewater network, metering and sampling devices, wastewater pre-treatment facilities and disposal systems.

3. The Licensee shall at any time grant the WMA access to all liquid flow process and metering devices, production facilities, internal wastewater facilities and wastewater metering,

sampling and monitoring facilities for the purpose of:

(b) Taking independent samples and readings for verification of water consumption and effluent volumes and/or quality. In case of an independent composite sample required by the WMA, the Licensee shall make necessary arrangements for collection of composite

samples at hourly intervals over a continuous 24 hour time period on the date prenotified by the WMA.

- 4. This Licence shall be governed by the Wastewater (Standards for Discharge of Industrial Effluent into a Waste Water System) Regulations 2004. The licensee undertakes to fulfill all the duties and obligations incumbent upon it in terms of the above Regulations.
- 6. This Licence is not transferable.
- 7. The Licensee shall notify the WMA within at least one month before:
 - (i) stopping discharge of effluent to the sewer network
 - (ii) changing its industrial activity
 - (iii) changing its process technology for the same industrial activity
 - (iv) increasing its water production due to increased activity

Items (ii) to (iv) above shall be subject to the express approval in writing of the WMA and subject to such conditions as the WMA may prescribe. In case of failure to obtain such approval, this Licence may be revoked.

- 8. Specific conditions to your industry:
 - i. <u>In case of non-compliance of your industrial effluent the following action steps shall</u> be followed:
 - Good house keeping shall be ensured, and clean production technology shall be adopted where possible, so as to minimize pollution load in industrial effluent.
 - Relevant expertise / Consultants shall be hired for investigation and design works for installation of required pre-treatment facilities. The proposed pre-treatment installations and an implementation schedule shall be submitted to the WMA within 3 months from the date of this Licence.
 - A Guarantee Certificate shall be submitted by the designer to the effect that the quality of treated effluents shall meet the required limits prescribed under the Waste Water Regulations 2004.
 - The required pre-treatment facilities shall be installed as per the submitted design and implementation schedule.
 - Your industry shall give evidence that experienced staff is employed for the operation and maintenance of the waste water facilities.
 - ii. Wastewater Management Authority will effect regular visits to ensure compliance.
