SECONDARY LEGISLATION

BOTANICAL GARDENS REGULATIONS 1922

GN 215/1922

The Nursery **Gardens** and the Curepipe **Botanical Gardens** are limited as follows: towards the north, by the properties Laverdan, Hill and James Vallet; towards the east, by the property of Mr. James Vallet; towards the south east, by **Botanical Gardens** Street and by the old road to the River Sèche; towards the south by the old road from the River Sèche to Barracks Street; towards the west, by properties Colonel Stuart, War Department, and Reunion morcellement. This limit is broken into five parts.

The area within the above limits is about fifty-six and a half arpents (Colonial measure).

The kiosks in the **Gardens** are at the disposal of the general public. Leave to use the kiosks for picnics may be obtained from the Chief Agricultural Officer, or the Mayor of the Municipal Council of Curepipe (if the kiosk is situated on the portion allocated to the Municipal Council called the Curepipe **Botanical Gardens**), on condition that proper care be taken of the kiosks, tables, benches, etc., and that they be left clean. A kiosk can be reserved on application to the Overseer of the **Gardens** at least twenty-four hours before it is wanted. Any person so reserving a kiosk shall be entitled to the exclusive use of the allocated kiosk and its surroundings. If on the appointed day and hour the reserved kiosk is not occupied by the persons for whom it shall have been reserved the privilege shall be ipso facto cancelled, and the kiosk will be at the disposal of any visitor.

The power to grant the use of the kiosks for picnics or otherwise is entirely in the discretion of the Chief Agricultural Officer, or the Mayor of the Municipal Council of Curepipe (as the case may be) who will be at liberty to refuse such use whenever he thinks proper.

No political, religious or public meeting shall be held in the Gardens.

Breaking-in of horses in the **Gardens** is prohibited. No person shall shoot, hunt or catch birds or animals in the **Gardens**. Fishing, bathing and washing in ponds, canals, streams or other watercourses of the **Gardens** are prohibited.

The above regulations shall apply to the Curepipe **Botanical Gardens** and Nursery **Gardens** and shall be in force within the area defined in paragraph (1) of these regulations.
