

Loud Speakers and Amplifiers (Restrictions of Use) (Rural Districts)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1959

Regulations made by the Commissioner of Police under section 3(1) (d) of
the **Noise Prevention** Ordinance

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Loud Speakers and, Amplifiers (Restrictions of Use) (Rural Districts) (Amendment) Regulations, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Loud Speakers and Amplifiers (Restriction of Use) (Rural Districts) Regulations, 1953, as subsequently amended, hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations shall have effect as if for the first proviso there were substituted the following proviso-

Provided that the prohibition in this Regulation imposed shall not apply to the use of loud speakers:-
 - (a) in connection with any Legislative, Municipal or Town Council Election at any time:-
 - (i) in the case of a Legislative Council Election from the date of issue of the writ of election, or
 - (ii) in the case of a Municipal or Town Council Election from the date of issue of the notice that an election will be held,

to the day preceding the day fixed for taking the poll.
 - (b) by the Police for the purpose of making announcements or of controlling or regulating traffic or crowds.
