Prevention of Noise (Victoria Hospital) Regulations 1939

GN No. 13 of 1939

Regulations made by the Commissioner of Police under Article 3 of the Prevention of Noise Act 1938.

- **1.** The use of motor horns, save in exceptional circumstances, within the area specified in Part I of the Schedule to these regulations, is prohibited.
- **2.** No person shall, within the area specified in Part II of the Schedule to these regulations, make any **noise** which interferes or is likely to interfere with the comfort of any patient or of any member of the resident staff of Victoria Hospital.
- **3.** Any person acting in contravention of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 500 rupees.
