

Prevention of Noise (Victoria Hospital) Regulations 1939

GN No. 13 of 1939

Regulations made by the Commissioner of Police under Article 3 of the Prevention of Noise Act 1938.

1. The use of motor horns, save in exceptional circumstances, within the area specified in Part I of the Schedule to these regulations, is prohibited.
2. No person shall, within the area specified in Part II of the Schedule to these regulations, make any **noise** which interferes or is likely to interfere with the comfort of any patient or of any member of the resident staff of Victoria Hospital.
3. Any person acting in contravention of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 500 rupees.
